



Jean-Pierre Contzen

Prof. Contzen studied engineering and nuclear physics at the *Université Libre de Bruxelles*.

He started his professional career in 1959 at the Nuclear Research Centre of Mol, moving in 1964 to the European Launcher Development Organisation ELDO and subsequently in 1969 to the European Space Organisation ESRO. He started in 1974 a 25 years' association with the European Commission occupying successively the posts of Director of Programmes of the Joint Research Centre (JRC), Director for Science & Technology Policy, Director General of the JRC and Special Adviser of the Commissioner in charge of External Relations.

He is currently Chairman of the Board of Directors von Karman Institute for Fluid Dynamics, Special Adviser to the Minister of Science, Technology and Higher Education of Portugal, Invited Professor at the Eurasian National University of Kazakhstan and President of the Russian Scientific Foundation "*Nansen International Environmental and Remote Sensing Centre*" in Saint Petersburg.

He is also a member of the Committee of Applied Sciences of the Royal Belgian Academy and Foreign Corresponding Member of the Academy of Sciences of Portugal.
